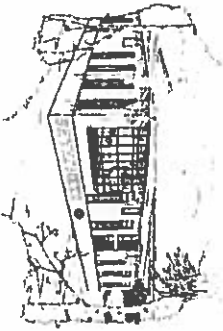

General Information

Hours

The Care operates from the time school lets out until 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Late Pickup

We expect your child to be picked up no later than 6:00 p.m. There is a \$10 charge for those who are late.



POINTS FOR PARENTS

- 1) Please label all uniforms, swim suits and towels. The children must have their gymnastic uniform and their swim suit with them every week in order to participate.
- 2) If your child is picked up early, please check them out with the office.
- 3) One of the goals of the program is to teach independence. We can better achieve this goal by teaching them to put their belongings in their proper place.
- 4) We will provide a special bag for their uniform items. We prefer your child not bring toys to avoid distractions.
- 5) If your child wears ear molds, talk with the swim teacher regarding a system of picking up the molds after class.
- 6) All payments and forms are to be turned in to the front office.

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🕒Ages

The Camp program allows children to attend from kindergarten through 5th grade. All of our children come from Highland Park, Doss and Casis Elementary Schools.

📅Registration

We begin registration for Fall After School Camp in March of each year. This program is extremely popular and usually fills within a few weeks. A \$100 registration fee and a registration form is required to sign up for this program.

🌞Holidays

After School Care will start and run through the Austin Independence School District (AISD) calendar. All AISD C-days and holidays are observed and the children will not attend the program on these days. Because the program is figured on the tuition for the year, there is no pro-rating for the above mentioned holidays.

💰Tuition

The tuition is paid monthly and may be pro-rated at times during the year for short months (ie, August, December, March and May/June).

📞If your child is going to be Absent

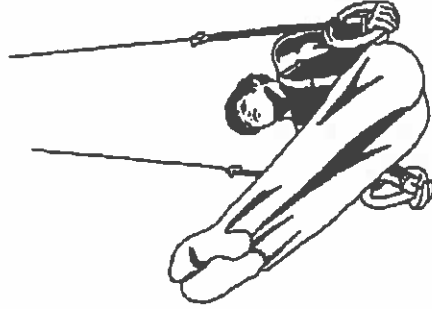
Parents must call or email prior to 2:00 p.m. if their child is going to be absent, otherwise a \$10 fee will be added to the next month's tuition.

🕒Late Tuition

Tuition is due prior to the 15th of each month. After that date, a \$10 late fee will be assessed.

📄Non Sufficient Funds Charges

There will be a \$25 fee for all returned checks. NSF checks will not be re-deposited. This will include ACH debit returns. You must bring in a money order, cashiers check or cash. (Please include the \$25 NSF fee with your replacement.)



Do the children need to wear special clothing for the program? Children come in their school clothes and will change into appropriate uniforms for the different activities such as gymnastics and swimming. We will provide an area for each child to keep these items during the week. We ask that parents take home the clothing on Fridays for washing.

How are the children disciplined? We concentrate on positive reinforcement to teach children to behave within their groups. Because our camp children are kept so active, the teachers rarely have to deal with problem children. If there are changes or problems at home which may effect your child, please make the teachers aware.

How do the rotations work? Teachers are hired for their expertise in the individual areas. Therefore, children rotate to the different teachers for their classes.

Do the children ever leave the building? All of our outdoor skills programs are taught at the neighboring park located next to Crenshaws. Perry Park has a well designed playground and playscape the children may use.

How do you select the teachers? Teachers are selected by their expertise and years of experience with school age children. The swim instructors are certified to teach swimming lessons.

How are the children divided into groups? Children are divided into groups according to grades. Adjustments are made for children who have needs other than the needs of his/her age group. Teachers are careful not to place children too far ahead as to eliminate constant struggling to keep up.

Are children allowed to attend for just a month or two? During the school-year this program is designed to run for the full nine months. The activities are based on the children attending throughout the year. Children attending for a very short period would be at a disadvantage.

What do you offer for this age during the summer? Check out many of our fine programs for this age child during the summer. We begin registration in March.

Sample Daily Schedule (The rotations may vary from group to group.)

2:57 - 3:20 p.m.	Pick up from school and enjoy a snack.
3:25 - 4:10 p.m.	Gymnastics twice a week Non gym days - Computer lab and Arts & Crafts.
4:10 - 4:45 p.m.	Homework time
4:45 - 5:15 p.m.	Outdoor Skills (Activities will vary throughout the year.)
5:15 - 5:45 p.m.	Various activities and wait for parent pickup.
5:45 - 6:00 p.m.	Prepare to close out the day.

Facility

Crenshaws is located in Northwest Austin off of Balcones Drive. This state of the art training facility is home for many different activities for children and adults. The indoor heated pool was built with teaching in mind. The 12,000 square foot gymnasium is equipped with both full size and scaled down gymnastic apparatus. All of the trampolines are ground level in ensure the utmost in trampoline safety. There is a special arts & crafts room and computer lab.

Student-Teacher Ratio

Our program student/teacher ratios are well below licensing requirements. For gymnastics, an additional teacher is added which will reduce the ratio to 1:8 or less. These extremely low ratios are just one of the reasons the program is so successful.

Parent Visitation

We welcome parents to come and observe anytime. Parents are asked to be aware if their presence is disrupting or distracting to the child. Parents are always asked to first check in with the office.

Commonly Asked Questions

What is After School Care? Crenshaws provides a unique experience in a wide variety of physical and mind expanding activities. Our skills program includes computer skills, arts & crafts, outdoor skills (Flag Football, Soccer, Kickball, Track, Basketball and Tether Ball), swimming and gymnastics. The goals of this program are to give our camp children a wide variety of skills, to increase their capacity to learn individually and within groups, and to learn to work happily and effectively while taking instruction with their peers.

How does the tuition rank with other After School Care Programs? Since there are few programs which attempt to provide so many different activities within one framework, it is difficult to compare our program with others. Considering the facility, curriculum and qualified staff, this program is a true bargain.
